The RSVP office in Webster City received a special visit from two AmeriCorps representatives who oversee our program. Torri Tuttle is a portfolio manager for the AmeriCorps North Central Region, and Kristin Honz is the Senior Portfolio Manager for our region. Both representatives visited a BASE senior fitness class in Duncombe before stopping by the Webster City office. Local RSVP volunteers Kathy Sonsalla, Gayle Olson, Sharon Abbas and Paula Brownell also came in to meet the representatives and talk about what they do as volunteers. AmeriCorps Seniors includes three programs that engage seniors aged 55+ in volunteerism: Foster Grandparent, Senior Companion, and RSVP.

### **Current Volunteer Opportunities**

These are some of the opportunities available to volunteers in Hamilton and Webster counties. If you are interested in an assignment in another community, RSVP can provide mileage reimbursement. For more information, call Becky Koppen at 515-832-2525.

#### Van Diest Medical Center

Greeters and guides are needed to help people reach their destination at the hospital. 6 timeslots available each day. Bedside visitors are needed to visit with patients. 1-2 hours, am or pm. Helpers are needed with post cataract surgery patient care.

#### <u>Elderbridge</u>

Volunteers are needed for a variety of activities including telephone reassurance, medical transportation driver, and errand buddy. Background check required.

#### Youth and Shelter Care

Volunteers are sought to spend time with young people playing games, having a movie night, doing crafts. Fort Dodge location. Background check required.

#### Village General Store

Thrift store supports Opportunity Village. Sort incoming donations, stock shelves, run cash register.

#### The Key on Central

Thrift store supports the Domestic/Sexual Assault Outreach Center in Fort Dodge. Volunteers are needed to sort and fold donated items, dust and vacuum set up displays, and carry boxes and bags.

#### Dayton Public Library/Harcourt Public Library

Volunteers are sought for a variety of activities including reading, book shelving, organizing, alphabetizing books, cleaning, making room for new books to be shelved, craft program helpers, and after school helpers.

#### Area Nursing Homes

Area nursing homes are looking for people to help with elderly activities such as Bingo, crafts, cards, and ono-onone visits.

#### **BASE Senior Fitness**

Leaders are needed for new locations of BASE Senior Fitness exercise classes. Training is provided by RSVP.

## The Inside Story: Hamilton County Public Health Offers Wide Range of Foot Care

The Foot Clinic, offered by Hamilton County Public Health, serves clients with a variety of care including toenail cutting, foot soak, lotion and massage, callous filing, and nail polishing. The cost is \$15, and clinics are held at several locations.

Clinic days are the 1st and 2nd Thursday at the Public Health office, the 3rd Thursday at Crestview Apartments, and the 4th Thursday every other month in Jewell. Anyone over the age of 60 is eligible for the Foot Clinic.

Good foot care is important for prevention of dry skin, prevention of infections, promotion of better mobility, and detection of circulation problems.

RSVP volunteer Paula Brownell calls clients every week to remind them of upcoming appointments, and also

helps as receptionist during each clinic. Peggy Roberts is the nurse who is dedicated to foot care. If you would like more information about the Foot Clinic, call Hamilton County Public Health at 515-832-9565.
